"LIKE KISSING A DOG"

A friend of mine recently told me about an experience he had during Sukkot/Feast of Tabernacles 2003. It seems that he fell into conversation with a de-bearded brother who revealed that his wife forbade him to retain his beard! She said that kissing a man with a beard was "like kissing a dog." Now certainly one would like to avoid something that is "like kissing a dog"...but exactly how to avoid this repugnant scenario needs to be carefully investigated and clearly understood.

The modern practice of shaving off the beard derives from the days of the ancient Roman Empire. History tells us that one of the major reasons for the decline and fall of that Empire was the development of a large and powerful homosexual community, which very interestingly expressed a strong preference for shaven men as partners in perversion. Apparently, the Creator's embedded networking software produced disturbing internal feedback when these sodomizers clutched bearded comrades in disgusting sexual embrace., .but they discovered that this feedback could be muted if their partners were de-bearded, i.e. made to look like the women they should be relating to.
